2024 Competition Guidelines

Creation Competition

Each entrant creates an **original design** using their own LEGO[®], DUPLO[®], Megablocks[®], or other LEGO[®] compatible plastic bricks. The design and building work will be done at home and entries will be submitted the morning of LEGO[®] mania. Entries are organized by age and evaluated for presentation, originality, theme, and design elements by a panel of judges.

New in 2024: Additional awards will be presented to the top builds with a musical theme.

Registration must be completed online at www.NorthviewBandBoosters.net by **February 16, 2024**. The fee is \$5.00/entry.

- Entrants may not use a design from a LEGO[®] kit, book, or online source for any part of their creation. **Original ideas and designs only**.
- Maximum size for entries is 24" wide x 24" deep x 48" tall.
- Parents and siblings should have minimal involvement in the building process so the competition is fair and the entry reflects the builder's age and experience level.
- If builders choose to work with a partner, the entry must be submitted under the oldest teammate's age. Only one medal is awarded if the team wins.
- Entries should include a typed title and description (half page or less). Parents/adults may assist children with typing, but the words/concepts should be the entrant's. Do NOT include a name on this sheet. Entries will be assigned an ID number for impartial judging.
- Every entrant receives a certificate, and the top three entries in each age category receive medals.
 - Entries must be brought to the Northview High School gym via the athletic entrance on **Saturday, March 9 between 9:00 am and 12:00 pm** and taken home by 8:15 pm.

People's Choice Award

Event attendees will be given 6 voting tickets. Attendees will vote for their favorite entries in any category by placing the ticket inside the envelope that corresponds to the creation they are voting for. The three entries with the most votes will get a special trophy.

Speed Building Competition

Ready, set, go! Entrants race their peers to build a new, unopened LEGO[®] set according to the official instructions. Each division competes using an age-appropriate LEGO[®] set. The first contestant in each division to correctly complete the set will win a medal. All entrants get to keep the set they build (approximately \$20 value). All competitors will check in by 4:30pm. Competition times will be 5:00pm and 6:30pm. Check your email for details the week of the event. Registration fee is \$25.00. Space for this event is limited and entrants will be accepted in the order received. To compete, entrants must register at www.NorthviewBandBoosters.net by February 16th.
